Professional dry clean

Taking care of the things
we love is one of the best ways
to ensure that they last.

With gentle care and attention, you can protect the lifespan
of your natural rug so it looks and feels beautiful from
one year to the next.

We recommend professional dry cleaning and following
these simple tips to ensure the longevity of your natural rug...

For our short-pile rugs, regular vacuuming with a nozzle
is essential. Unless dirt is removed, particles can work
their way deep down into the rug pile, causing wear and
tear and eventually leading to breakage of the fibres.

Fluff or pilling on the surface of your rug is a natural result
of yarn compression when it is made. Vacuum regularly
with a nozzle using gentle pressure so as to not disturb
the natural wool fibres and this should settle over time.



Accidental spills

Make sure you do not scrub at the spill or use abrasive cleaners, as this will likely make the stain worse.

We suggest that you blot it immediately with a clean, dry cloth. Always ensure that the cloth you are using does not have any detergents from previous use. Many surface cleaners have bleach in them and this could lead to a permanent stain.

3

Use a clean, wet cotton cloth and leave it on the spill until it has been absorbed. Then, if needed, dab the stain by working from the edge inwards.
